Job Title: Adolescent Non-Violence Program Counselor

Position Description:

We are looking for a compassionate and team-oriented Counselor to join our Battering Intervention and Prevention Program (BIPP) team, providing psychoeducational group intervention, intake, individual services, and exit sessions for adolescents referred through juvenile probation and other community agencies. The Counselor will also provide psychoeducational group interventions to adult men with a focus on parenting/fatherhood.

Main Position Activities:

- Plan and facilitate intervention groups for adolescent/adult family violence perpetrators working closely with community referring agencies.
- Effectively implement victim-centered Fatherhood group(s) for adult males.
- Conduct orientation, intake and exit sessions for participants.
- Meet with parents/guardians of child/adolescent clients for intakes and parent consults as necessary.
- Provide individual services as needed
- Provide public education, in-service workshops, and professional training presentations as assigned.
- Provide supervision and support to student interns and volunteers serving as co-facilitators.
- Maintain professional relationships with area adult/juvenile probation departments, parole, district attorney's office, judges and child protective services to assure best delivery of services to clients.

Qualifications:

- Minimum Master's degree in counseling or social work or relevant field
- Licensed as LPC, LMFT, LCSW, or Licensed Psychologist
- Demonstrated understanding of the dynamics of relationship violence and sexual assault; knowledge and understanding of current Parenting/Fatherhood practices.
- Battering intervention, victim advocacy, child welfare and/or juvenile probation experience preferred
- Ability to work effectively with adult/adolescent male and female clients
- Ability to work a flexible schedule including evening and Saturday hours
- Must have a valid driver's license and a clean driving record
- Bilingual (Spanish) preferred
