Job Title: Director of Residential and Crisis Services

We are looking for a compassionate and team-oriented Director of Residential and Crisis Services to join our agency. The ideal candidate would have strong leadership skills and experience in managing operations and service delivery of a residential crisis facility.

Main Position Activities:

- Supervision of shelter staff to include all employment actions and scheduling for shelter and crisis line services
- Conduct weekly meetings with staff to include training, building communication and morale, and coordinating services for clients.
- Manage the shelter facility to meet the physical, safety-related and emotional needs of the clients.
- Collect and report statistical data reflecting services provided and outcomes.
- Evaluate shelter services and make recommendations for budget needs and programming in support of agency goals.
- Ensure clients have access to counseling, support group, and advocacy services.
