The ideal candidate would have strong safety planning skills, knowledge of the civil and criminal systems, will know how to provide clients with options, excellent organizational/caseload management skills, and flexibility.

Main Position Activities:

- Deliver case management, crisis intervention and information/referrals to domestic violence and sexual assault victims through face-to-face and/or telephone contact.
- Coordinate with local law enforcement agencies, child protective services, district attorney's office, child support and civil court system and other social service agencies to implement victim response and services
- Assist clients in developing and maintaining an individualized service plan focusing on safety.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in social work or a related field, or equivalent experience
