**Job Title:** Survivors Advocacy Team (SAT) Coordinator

We are looking for a compassionate and team-oriented Survivors Advocacy Team (SAT) Coordinator to join our agency. The ideal candidate would have strong organizational skills and the ability to build and maintain relationships with volunteers and community stake-holders.

**Main Position Activities:**

- Coordinate agency Survivors Advocacy Team (SAT) program and develop and present educational, primary prevention, and training programs on domestic violence and sexual assault.
- Assist in Coordinating SAT: organize monthly on-call calendar, provide support and guidance to SAT volunteers, maintain SAT Supplies, and all other activities needed for the SAT program.
